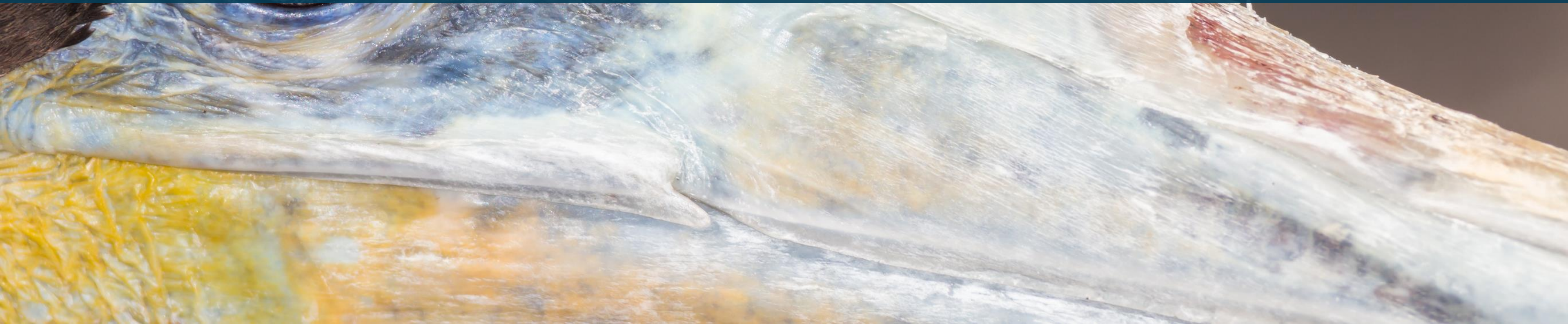

PRACTICAL ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE

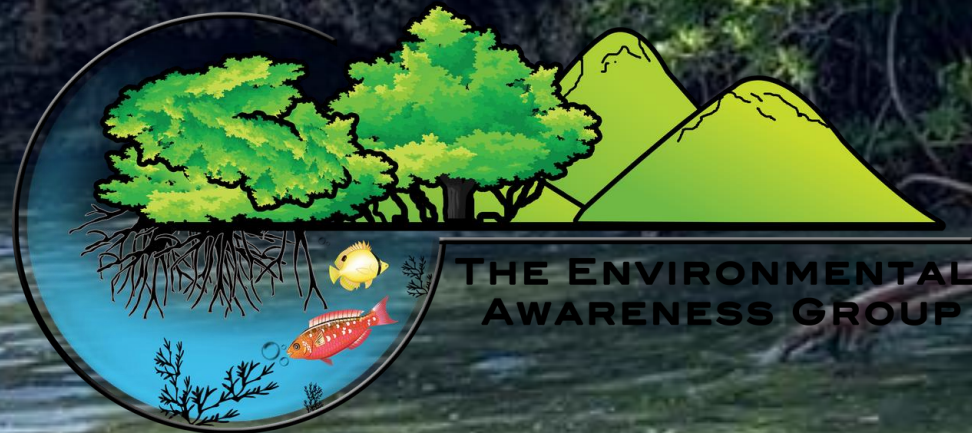
- **Inclusion in Decision-making**
